



GARDEN SERIES FOR HOMESCHOOLERS

Work with our Master Gardeners, who will help you learn about preparing and all that is involved with planting a garden. In this program, you will help plant the garden at Tank Cottage, which will be open for thousands of visitors to see throughout the summer!

March 15 - Greenhouse Planting

Some plants take a long time to grow before they're ready for us to eat. Plant the seeds for the park with our Master Gardener Volunteers. Learn about the different crops that will show up in our gardens, and even take a seed home to start your own!

May 1 - Cold Crop Planting

Just like people, some plants prefer cooler weather. Learn about these plants and help plant them in our first session in Tank Garden!

June 5 - Planting Tank Garden

Help us move the seeds that were planted in March into Tank Garden, as well as plant more seeds. Learn about which plants are friends and can grow next to each other and which ones simply don't get along!

June 28 - Early Harvest and Scarecrows

Our first crops should be ready by this date, and we will be picking some for you to take home! We will also have fun making some scarecrows for the Tank Garden.

August 9 - Second Harvest

Join us for our second harvest, when many of the crops will be ready. You will get to take some crops home along with a recipe to use them in. Learn about the science behind cooking in our last garden series program.
