



Field Trip Expectations

Please read the following to your students and chaperones before they arrive at Heritage Hill.

You are about to travel back in time and experience how your life might have been if you lived 100 years ago or more! Before we can start our journey, there are some things you need to know.

1. Some of the items in the buildings are over 100 years old! Please be respectful of all of the objects, and do not touch them unless you are given permission.
2. No food, drinks, gum, or backpacks are allowed in the buildings. You can either leave your backpack on the bus or outside of the buildings.
3. All students' cell phones, tablets, and other valuable items should be left on the bus. Heritage Hill isn't responsible for anything you lose, and it's a big park, so it might be hard to find items!
4. All cell phones brought into the park should be left on vibrate so as to not disturb the programming. If adults need to take a call, please do so outside of the buildings.
5. There is a trailer inside the gate next to the visitor center that we will put our lunches on. We will need to bring our lunches back to the bus after we're done with our program(s) and pick up all of our garbage.
