## Field Trip Rules and Guidelines

**In order to have a safe and fun experience, we ask that you adhere to the below park rules:**

- Help us protect the historic buildings by not having food, drink, or gum inside.
- There will be plenty of chances to do historic activities today! Please only touch things that our historic interpreters tell you can be touched!
- Be sure to ask lots of questions throughout the day!
- Don't forget to clean your lunch area to leave the park cleaner than when you arrived.
- Please take as many photos as you want and share them on social media! You'll find Heritage Hill on Facebook and Instagram.
- All lunches, backpacks, coolers, etc. should be placed on the Heritage Hill trailer which will transport them to/from your lunch area.
- Stay with your group! Heritage Hill requires 1 adult for every 15 students. Each group will start their Heritage Hill experience in a different area of the park to help stagger groups and ensure everyone has the best day possible.
- Your field trip is self-guided, which means you can explore the park at your own pace. While there are no guided tours or formal activities, the historic interpreters are onsite to engage students in informal, hands-on learning. This could be helping in the garden, portaging a canoe, participating in military drills, etc. Activities vary daily.
