**Heritage Hill to host its 17th annual “Hops on the Hill” event on Thursday,

**GREEN BAY, Wis. (June 24, 2025)** - Heritage Hill State Historical Park will host its 17<sup>th</sup> annual “Hops on the Hill” fundraiser event on July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025. The event will take place from 5:30 pm until 8:00 pm that day.

In partnership with Dean Distributing and Minzo’s Kitchen, the event will feature craft beer, wine, spirits and savory tailgate food pairings. In addition, there will be a raffle and a silent auction held on-site during the event. Hops on the Hill will feature live music by the band NUstalgic throughout the day as well. Hops on the Hill will also be joined by local radio personality host Otis Day as Emcee.

“Hops on the Hill is one of our largest annual fundraisers. This event provides a fun and entertaining evening while simultaneously supporting our mission and vision for the park.” said Diana Fligelman, Director of Sales and Events at Heritage Hill. “Most people are unaware that Heritage Hill is a non-profit organization that relies heavily on the support of ticket sales from special events like Hops on the Hill.
