A Memorial Day Observance at Heritage Hill

GREEN BAY, Wis. (May 14, 2026) Heritage Hill State Historical Park will host A Memorial Day Observance on Monday, May. 25 from 10:00 – 11:00 a.m. offering a meaningful opportunity to pause, reflect and pay tribute to the fallen heroes who have served our nation.

The observance will feature performances by the Fort Howard Guard Fife & Drum Corps, remarks from Wisconsin State Senator Jamie Wall as well as additional speakers. Pastor Chad Baudhuin of All Saints Church will be giving an invocation as well.

“As we gather this Memorial Day, we pause not only to remember the fallen, but to honor the lives, courage and selflessness behind each sacrifice.” Said Rose Gallenberger, Director of Engagement, Heritage Hill. “We are honored to provide a space where the community can gather to reflect, remember and honor their sacrifice.”

In addition to the performances and speakers, local chapters of the Sons of the American Revolution and the Daughters of the American Revolution will be performing a wreath laying at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
